HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

This guide contains details of all artists, artist groups and venues taking part. Each entry is listed according to which area of Peterborough they are in, divided into five art trails. They each have a map reference number, so you can see where they are located on the maps in this guide. Simply select which artist or venue you want to visit, check when they're open and make your visit. There's no need to book in advance, and there's no admission charge for any studio.





Trails offer a unique way to explore Peterborough. We have five suggested routes from artists, linking studios, local attractions as well as refreshment stops. Trail numbers are shown on top of each map and show the area they cover. The trails are a good opportunity to see many artists over one of the weekends, and remember if you visit more than eight venues you can enter our free prize draw too.

Whether you choose to take a tour around the Thorpe Meadows Sculpture Trail, encounter a bird sculpture or carved benches at Ferry Meadows, or glimpse Antony Gormley's figures watching over Cathedral Square, we hope you discover an artwork that you enjoy or that intrigues you to find out more



Thorpe Meadows Sculpture Trail

The trail explores the unique sculptures on display within the backdrop of the Park, taking you alongside the rowing lake, the River Nene, through meadows and woods. The trail also passes through the 'Street Art Gallery' under the Parkway. Thorpe Meadows Sculpture Trail is free to visit and is open all year. The trail is 3.2 km/2 miles and takes approximately 1hr to complete.

The Peterborough Sculpture Collection was originally created by the Peterborough Development Corporation between 1978 and 1988. Sculptures by Jeni Cairns, Lee Mawby and Jason Thomson, sited in Ferry Meadows and commissioned by Nene Park Trust, are more recent additions to The Collection.
